### APPOINTMENTS

- Enrolled Cambia Health Solutions employees in Utah can be seen by our contracted provider, Dr. Brian Black, and receive their Willamette Dental benefits
- All appointments are offered or coordinated by Dr. Brian Black at Blackstone Dental, including specialty and dental emergency appointments

### ORTHODONTIC SERVICES

- Patients must be seen by Dr. Black for a consultation to see if they are a candidate for orthodontic treatment
- If a candidate, Dr. Black's office will coordinate a referral to a local Salt Lake City orthodontist

### OUT-OF-POCKET EXPENSES FAQs

- General office visit copay – \$15 due at each general office visit, including orthodontic and pediatric appointments
- Specialty office visit copay – \$30 copay is collected instead of the general office visit copay when patients see an endodontist, periodontist or oral surgeon. It does not apply to pediatric or orthodontic appointments
- Out-of-Area Emergency for pain, bleeding, swelling, etc. will reimburse up to \$100. Out-of-area is defined as 50+ miles away from Dr. Black's office in Salt Lake City or any Willamette Dental office in Oregon, Washington or Idaho
- Patients can go to any Willamette Dental office (OR/WA/ID) regardless of home state and pay their plan copays
- Orthodontics – no age limit, \$150 pre-ortho is applied to full orthodontics copay if banded
- External referrals – coordinated external referrals have same copays as your Willamette Dental plan
- Fillings – amalgam fillings and composite fillings are covered with the general office visit copay

### CLEANINGS

- Number of cleanings covered is based on individual needs of the patient as prescribed and can range from 1 – 4 per year depending on patient's oral health, risk factors, etc. Not limited to every 6 months/2 per year
